You can laze around, enjoy the breeze, eat when you feel like it, drink ice-cold grog like there's no tomorrow for there's no need to drive home, sleep when sleep hits you..... Basically you have a BREAK from routine!

4. **What do I need?**

Transportation (no need for any four-wheel drives),
